# Mobile Phone Policy

### PURPOSE

To explain to our school community Kalinda Primary School's policy requirements, and expectations regarding the safe and appropriate use of mobile phones by students, at school or during school activities.

### SCOPE

This policy applies to all students at Kalinda Primary School.

### POLICY

Kalinda Primary School understands that students may bring a mobile phone to school, particularly if they are travelling independently to and from school or to extra-curricular activities.

During school hours, mobile phones must be:

- switched off
- signed in at the office prior to school and signed out at the end of the day
- must not be left in school bags or with the student.

### Mobile phone use

Mobile phones must not be used:

- to send inappropriate, harassing or threatening messages or phone calls
- to engage in inappropriate social media use including cyber bullying
- to capture video or images of people, including students, teachers and members of the school community without their permission
- to capture video or images in the school toilets, changing rooms and gym.

Students who use their mobile phone inappropriately at school may be issued with consequences consistent with our school's *Student Wellbeing and Engagement* and/or *Bullying* policies.

Students are responsible for their mobile phone when not at the office. Please note that the Kalinda Primary School does not have accident insurance for accidental property damage. Students and their parents/carers are encouraged to obtain appropriate insurance for valuable items, including mobile phones that may be brought to school. Students are responsible for items brought to school.

### Camps and excursions

In most circumstances, students will not be allowed to bring their mobile phones on overnight school camps or excursions. Kalinda Primary School will provide students and their parents and carers with information about items that can be brought to special activities and events, including mobile phones.
